What you will need:

Clear Gorilla Glue (not super glue)

Powder Resin (Let's Resin)

Container to mix glue & resin

Paint brushes

Babywipes

Toothpicks or Small wooden art files

Broken Item (ceramic/porcelain)

## Instructions

- Make sure your broken pieces are clean & dry.
- Remember the process is supposed to be slow and mindful.
- Mix Glue and Resin using a toothpick.
- Spread mixture onto the edge of broken piece.
- Spread on the other edge of broken piece.
- Press pieces together and hold until glue hardens.
- Use babywipes to wipe away excess before glue hardens.
- Remember that the beauty is in the imperfection and allow for the glue-resin to drip/thicken in some places.
